Presentations are being sought for a 60-minute plenary and breakout sessions for BIAC's 2020 Symposium. This event will have two tracks: one aimed at survivors/caregivers of a brain injury and the other for B.I. professionals. Topics relevant to either or both audiences in the areas of self-advocacy, wellness, resilience, practical applications of technological advances, rehabilitation, community integration, substance use dependency, and behavioral health co-occurrence are encouraged. Presentation objectives should include enhancing audience members' capacity to explore best and emerging strategies.

The conference audience members consist of case managers, therapists, social workers, medical and rehabilitation professionals, education professionals, survivors, caregivers, family members, as well as those that work with survivors experiencing justice-involvement and homelessness.

Breakout session timeframe will include introductions and presentation material, with 15 minutes left for Q&A. Attendees should leave with specific knowledge and skills about various aspects of the topic and how it relates to their lives or work.
