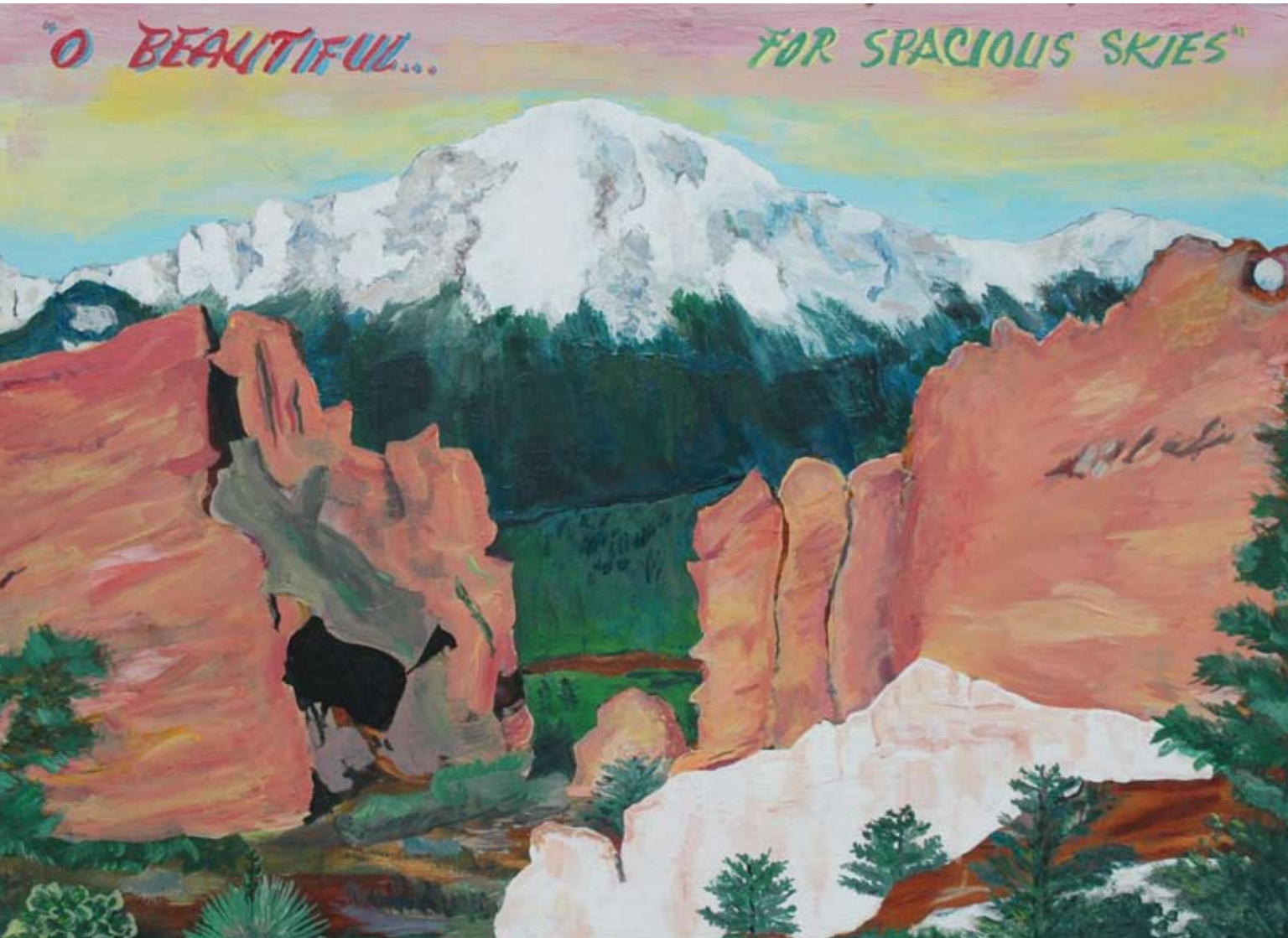

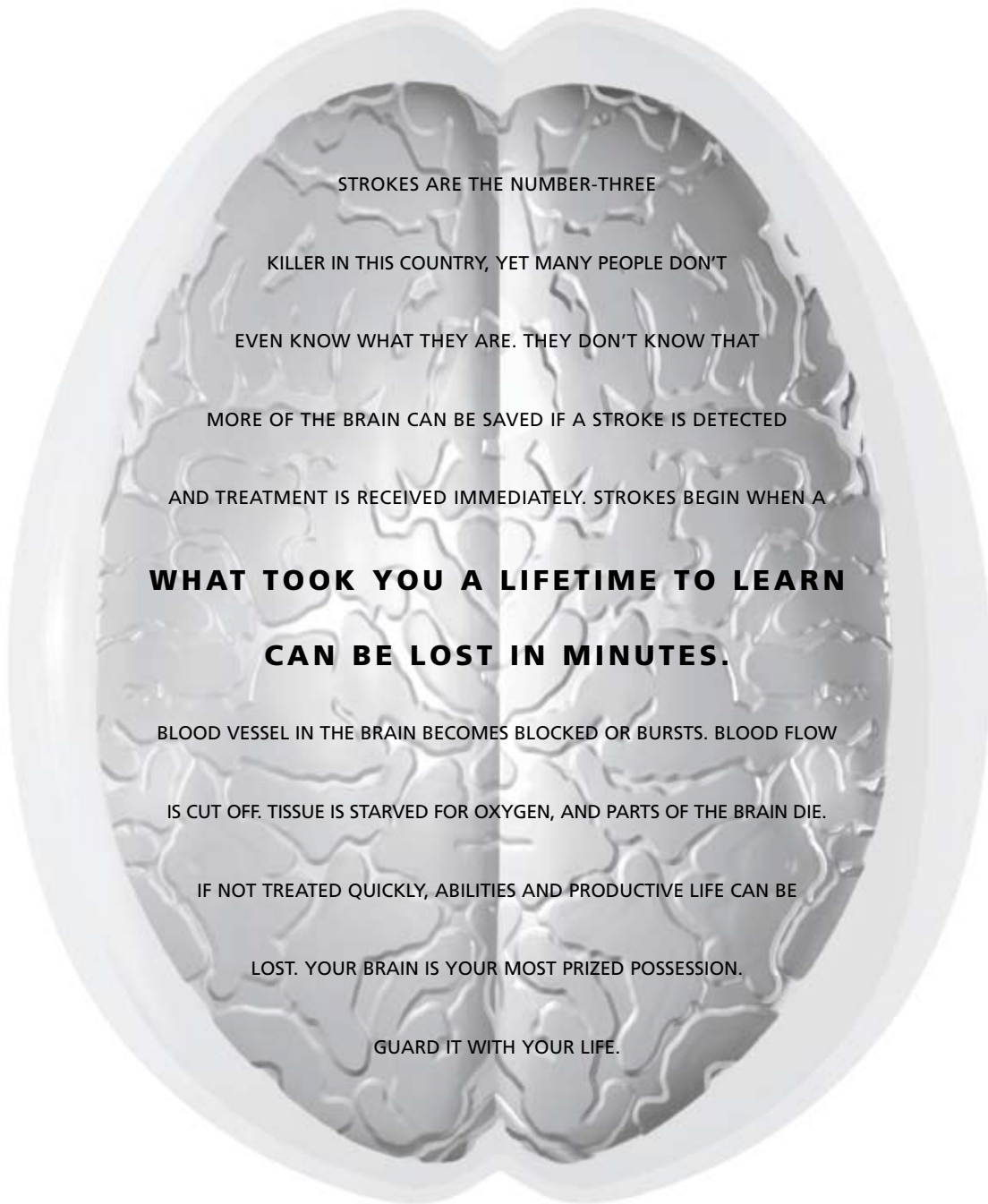

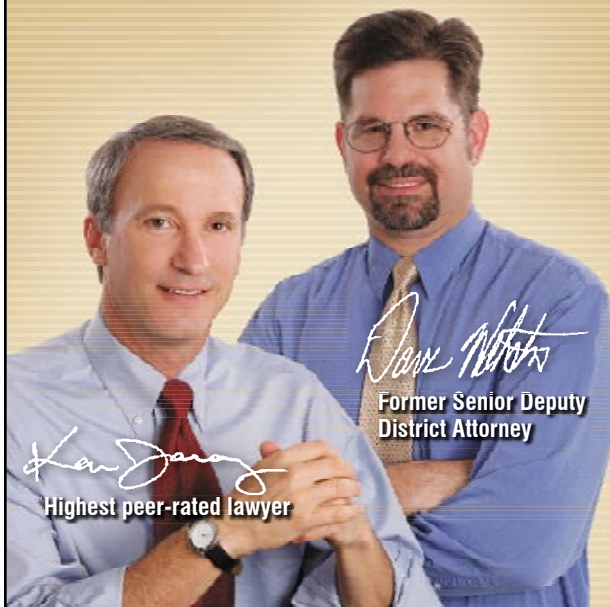
living with a brain injury. This directory is a work in progress and we hope to update it and expand it every two years.

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How many people have TBI?

Of the 1.4 million who sustain a TBI each year in the United States:

- 52,000 die
- 275,000 are hospitalized
- 1.36 million are treated and released from an emergency department or who receive no care is unknown

The number of people with TBI who are not seen in an emergency department or who receive no care is unknown.

What causes TBI?

The leading causes of TBI are:

- Falls (28%)
- Motor vehicle-traffic crashes (20%)
- Struck by/against (19%)
- Assaults (11%)

Blasts are a leading cause of TBI for active duty military personnel in war zones.

What are the long-term consequences of TBI?

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention estimates that at least 5.3 million Americans currently have a long-term or lifelong need for help to perform activities of daily living as a result of a TBI.

According to one study, about 40% of those hospitalized with a TBI had at least one unmet need for services one year after their injury. The most frequent unmet needs were:

- Improving memory and problem solving
- Managing stress and emotional upsets
- Controlling one's temper
- Improving one's job skills

TBI can cause a wide range of functional changes affecting thinking, language, learning, emotions, behavior, and/or sensation. It can also cause epilepsy and increase the risk for conditions such as Alzheimer's disease, Parkinson's disease, and other brain disorders that become more prevalent with age.

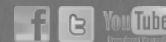

Free and appropriate education is available to all children kindergarten through twelfth grade in public education, including students with mild to severe brain injury. If your child has sustained a brain injury, contact the school district in which your child is enrolled to inform them of your child's history and to work with the school to determine eligibility for specialized programming such as health care plan, Section 504 Plan, or Special Education Individual Education Plan (covering children birth to age 21).

Mild TBI or Post Concussive-Syndrome

- Brief or no loss of consciousness
- 90% of concussions resolve within a few weeks
- 10% have symptoms that last a lifetime
 - Symptoms are not “mild”

Typical Effects of Mild to Moderate BI
