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Research Study Investigates Concussion and Brain Health in Older Adults 65+

Research Goals:

Investigate how structural changes in the brain correlate to cognitive decline

Collect and analyze fluid biomarkers for the detection of inflammation and Alzheimer's disease-related risk factors

Examine the relationship between concussion and the aging process

Participants will receive:

- Compensation provided
- Snacks and refreshments
- Medical screening; neurological exam
- Optional review of cognitive assessment scores with investigator after completion of 1 year follow-up visit

Location

- This study involves 2 research visits: a baseline and a one year follow-up visit at the University of Colorado Anschutz Medical Campus.

You may qualify if you:

- Are 65 years or older
- Had a concussion within the past 5 years
- Talked with a Doctor about your concussion
- Have not been diagnosed with a memory disorder
